Sadly, we inform you that Boris' father quietly passed away in his sleep.

Stjepan Miksic was born October 29th, 1918 in Karlovac, Croatia. He passed away March 4th, 2008 at the age of 89. He will be memorialized on Friday, March 7th in Zagreb, Croatia and also in St. Paul, Minnesota, which will be announced at a later date.



He is survived by his lovely wife Nina, son Boris, grandchildren Evonne and Paul, brother Tomica, and sisters Ankica & Katica.

He was born one of 18 children in the beautiful country of Croatia. He led a particularly healthy and strong life despite a battle with Tuberculosis at the age of 40.



He was born on the last day of World War I. He fought as a fighter pilot in World War II and lived through the Croatian War for Independence from Yugoslavia. He lived to tell many stories of a large piece of Croatian history. Mostly, he enjoyed a quiet, healthy life with Nina by his side and Boris as his legacy.
